Elliott Wulff's interests and talents include reading, writing, hiking, playing the piano, violin and singing opera. Elliott often sings solos at Temple Adat Shalom and has led the children's holiday services of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur since he was 9 years old.

He performs during fund raisers, weddings, Bar-Mitzvahs and other functions in the San Diego area. He has won an associated arts scholarship in 2008 and in April of 2009, being the youngest among 30

classically trained contestants between the ages of 14-17, Elliott won second place. Additionally, Elliott holds a second-degree black belt (Tae Kwon Do style) in the martial arts.

The performance will last about 25 minutes, including a very short introduction before each song.

Lorraine Thall will accompany Elliott on the piano.

Among the list of 6 songs, there is one song it particular which Elliott would like to sing called: "You can't succeed on Broadway if you don't have any Jews."

From a Broadway musical called "Spamalot." It was a hit during the Men's Club breakfast at Adat Shalom. (Please let me know what you think.)

Here is the list of the other songs that Elliott plans on singing: "Empty Chairs At Empty Tables" from Le Miserable," "Old Man River" from the musical "Showboat," "Torna - a - Surriento" An Italian song sang by: Ernesto De Curtis, "Stars" from: "Le Miserable" and "Bring Him Home" also from: "Le Miserable."

If there is time left and as a possible Encore, he might sing "O Sole Mio" in Italian.

birds to socialize.

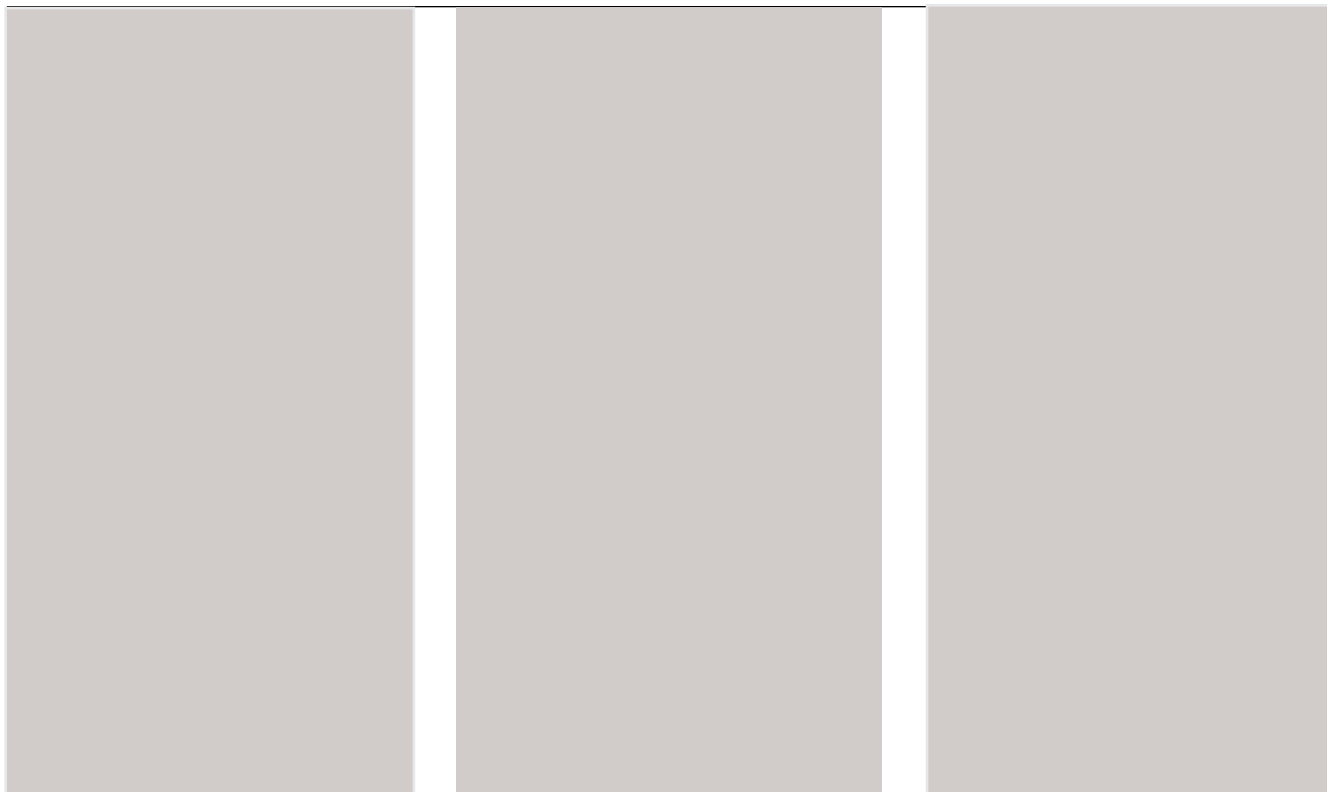
