Who Is Jack Mitchell?

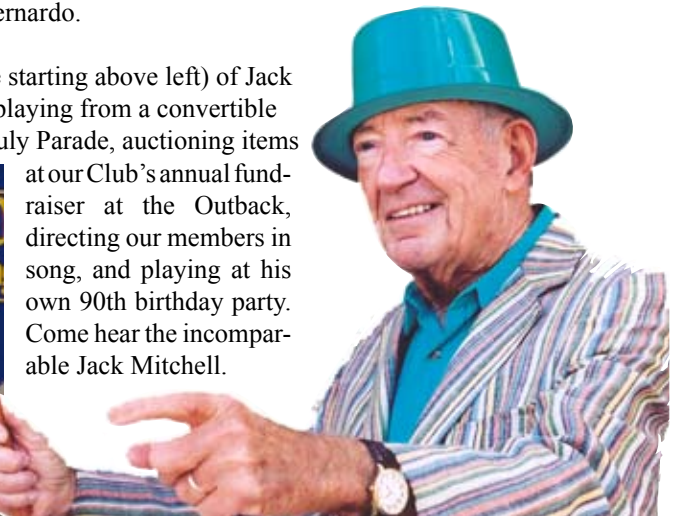


Jack will reveal all on Thursday when he speaks to our club on how his life evolved and the impact he has tried to have on the communities in which he has lived.

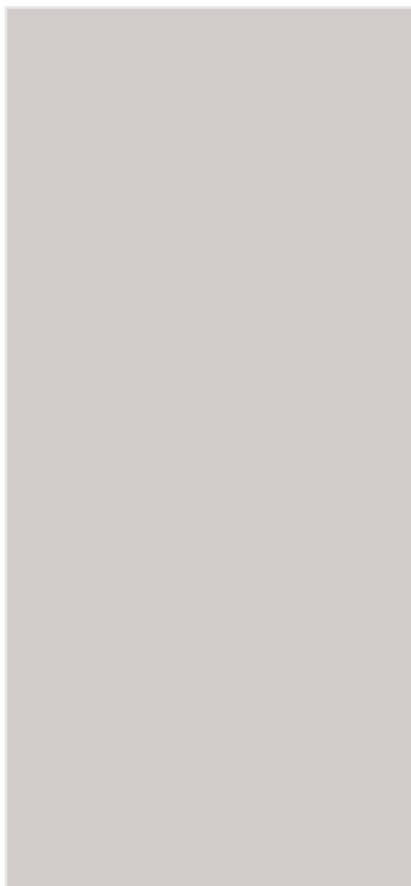
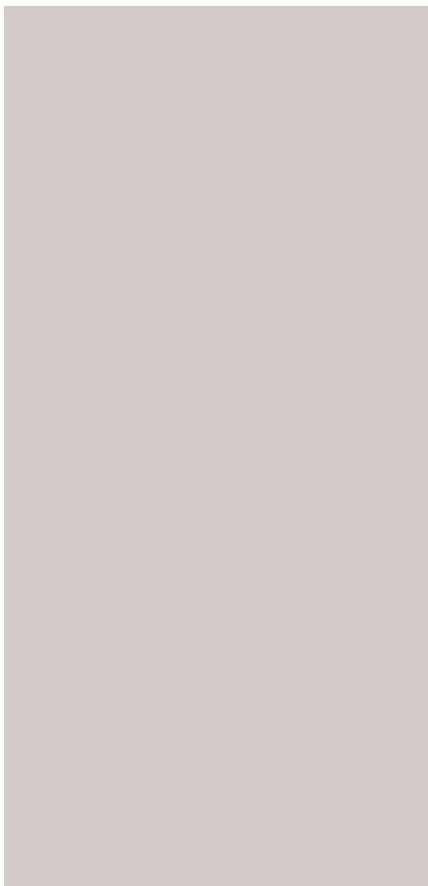
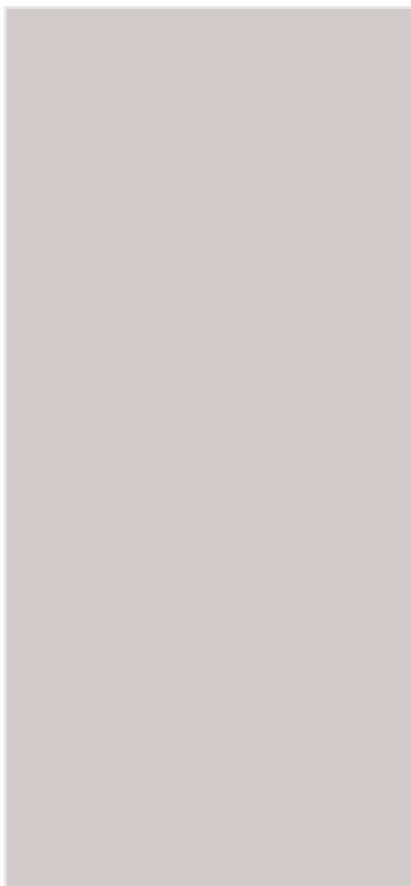
