## The Status of Poway Unified

### The current cut backs and the effects they are having on our schools

**D**on Phillips, who is in his ninth year as PUSD Superintendent, will speak to our club on Thursday.

In 2008, the American Association of School Administrators named him California State Superintendent of the Year.

The Poway Unified School District encompasses an area of 100 square miles and operates 25 elementary schools (K-5), six middle schools (6-8), four comprehensive high schools (9-12), and one continuation high school.

Twenty-five schools are located in the city of San Diego; eleven schools in the city of Poway. The District serves approximately 33,000 students and is the third largest school district in the county.

A former social science teacher, Mr. Phillips holds a Masters Degree in Education and a Doctorate in Education, Administration, Planning, and Social Policy from Harvard.

He was selected as superintendent of Poway Unified School District in September of 2001 and has 24 years of experience in the field of education administration.

He served as principal at both the middle

and high school levels and has many years of experience as a school district superintendent.

Mr. Phillips is also an active member of many superintendent advisory groups, including the National College Board Superintendent's Advisory Committee, the CSBA Superintendent's Council, the Executive Committee of the AASA Governing Board, and he was recently elected to the office of President-elect of the Suburban School Superintendents for 2005.

On the personal side, he and his wife, Robyn, have been married for 32 years and have two sons, Reid and Blake. He likes to play tennis, golf, spend time in the mountains, read, and be with his family.

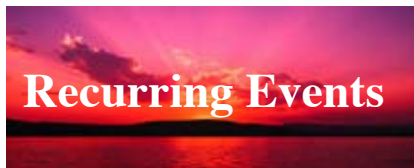
